# What we do...

## Wildlife

We fund habitat creation projects such as the Butterfly/Sensory Garden, and install bird and bat boxes in the Wildlife Reserve.



## Events

We run regular bird and bat walks as well as one-off special events.



## Brass on the Grass

We organise a series of summer concerts. These free events are held near the Arts & Crafts Shelter in the Arboretum.
