

Friends of Christchurch Park Partner with Suffolk Wildlife Trust to Offer Summer Park Events

The Friends of Christchurch Park are delighted to support two events for families and young children in the Park this August.

As part of their summer programme, which includes the highly popular Brass on the Grass concerts, the Friends of Christchurch Park are partnering with Suffolk Wildlife Trust to offer two events.

The first event, **Family Night Safari**, takes place on Friday 6th August between 9.00 and 10.30pm and involves searching for nocturnal species that make the Park their home.

The second event is **Mad about Mabel**, takes place on Wednesday 11 August 10.30am – 12noon, which is based around the nationally-famous Tawny Owl which has been nesting in the Park for many years. The event is suitable for children aged 5 -14 years and features the dissection of owl pellets.

Ticket prices for each event are as follows: an adult and child ticket costs ± 5 (additional children ± 2.50).
